## Come on out for the launch of Fall Trail Work - Saturday, October 13

This year our main jobs will be adding rocks along the Sagebrush Trail, widening the Skyline Trail, and doing maintenance on all three of our trails. On **Saturday, October 13**, we'll meet near the Trailhead Park restrooms at **9:00 AM**. We'll have work parties every Saturday and Sunday until the weather turns cold, usually around Thanksgiving. We'll start at 9:00 and generally go until 1:00. Where we meet will depend on that day's work. There will also be work mid-week and we can schedule a private work party for any group. In general, the work is suitable for teens and older people, though some jobs will be easy enough for grade schoolers to help, so this can be a great project for families.

I especially need helpers mid-week. I'll send out emails announcing all the work parties. To be added to my list, <u>send me an email</u> or call me at 943-3992. That way, I can plan the work and have enough tools available, and so that you'll know where we meet. As always, bring work gloves, water, and snacks, and dress for the weather. Tools will be provided. We very much appreciate whatever help you give.

No doubt you've noticed the improvements in the Skyline Trailhead area. The driveway from Dallas Road has been widened and upgraded, and the parking lot has been nearly doubled in size. Working in partnership with Benton County, much appreciation to Badger Mountain South (which is creating the new development on the south side of Badger), Rotschy GC engineers, and the City of Richland.
